Edgbaston Guinea Gardens is a collection of Victorian gardens created for the benefit of the shopkeepers and workers from the Jewellery Quarter and have existed for over a century. Find out about the history of the gardens with guide and allotmenteer Carol Dealey and explore some of them for yourself.

After lunch at the nearby Botanical Gardens (not included in the price) we will take a guided tour of Birmingham Botanical Gardens, which were founded in 1829. The Gardens were designed by JC Loudon, a Scotsman who was a leading garden planner and horticultural journalist.

Parking and toilets are available at the Botanical Gardens, which is a short (approx. 1.5 miles) walk from Guinea Gardens, although parking for those with mobility issues can be accommodated at the Guinea Gardens. Guinea Gardens are NOT suitable for wheelchairs or mobility scooters but the Botanical Gardens are accessible.
