Join Ladbroke Heritage tour guide, Jackie West, on a guided exploration of Ladbroke Church. Dating from the 12th century, Ladbroke church is distinctive for its striped tower and fine stained glass. It was transformed in 1876 by Sir Gilbert Scott, better known for the front of St Pancras Station, London. Hear about Ladbroke's links with the Catesby family, who held the manor of Ladbroke until Robert Catesby, leader of the Gunpowder Plot, sold it in 1596. The new owners were Alice and Robert Dudley, son of Queen Elizabeth 1st's favourite. After a self-guided walk through the village, attendees will enjoy refreshments at Ladbroke Village Hall, where further heritage displays will be available.
