




“The Churches of Over Whitacre and Lea Marston”

Saturday 25th September 2021

2 pm to 4 pm



Our afternoon starts at 2 pm at the Georgian Church of St Leonard, Nuneaton Road, Over Whitacre, B46 2NG. The present church, in the Baroque style, was built in 1765 but a chapel has existed in Over Whitacre from as early as 1203. Rita Poulson will give us the history of this beautiful chapel on a hill, as well as bringing to life the many characters connected with the Church during its history. We then take a 10 minute car journey to Lea Marston where we will visit and learn about St John the Baptist Church, Church Lane, Lea Marston, B46 1GA. This church, on the edge of the village, is very different in style. It was the Estate Church for the nearby Hams Hall Estate (which no longer remains), belonging to the Adderley family. The afternoon will finish at approximately 4 pm. This outing offers parking at both sites and minimal walking. Both sites are accessible for wheelchairs (although the path from the car park to St Leonard's is on an incline). Toilets at St Leonard's. Some time will be spent outside in the churchyards where the ground may be uneven. Both churches are spacious and social distancing can be maintained.
