First and foremost a family home, Packington Hall was built in 1693 but was substantially altered and extended in the 1770s by the third Earl of Aylesford. It remained almost unchanged for the next 200 years until a serious fire in 1979. The house was restored as near as possible to the original by the present Earl and Countess of Aylesford and is now lived in by their son and daughter-in-law, Lord and Lady Guernsey, and their young family. Enjoy a guided tour of the house with Lady Guernsey and a visit to the grounds and gardens, including the Pleasure Grounds designed by Capability Brown in 1751, one of his earliest works. After refreshments (included in the price) we will visit St James' Church, part of the Packington Estate. It is a rebuilding of the former church by the fourth Earl of Aylesford to commemorate the return to sanity of George III in 1789. With notice, the house is accessible for wheelchairs although some areas of the grounds are not accessible.
